



GOLI FIFA Tournament

General Rules

Set Up

- Fixtures for the initial round will be emailed out by Monday 20th April 2020 with the following rounds being emailed out once all the previous matches have been completed.
- Players should add their opponent and invite them to play.
- Matches should be 6-minute halves with default FIFA settings and squads.
- Players **MUST** use their chosen team for the duration of the tournament.
 - Any team can be selected from the game, including National Teams.

Gameplay

- During play, headsets and mics are not to be used, anyone found to be in breach of this will forfeit their game 5-0 and will be automatically dismissed from the tournament.
- Should a game be tied at the end of the 90 minutes, games should be completed using traditional extra time and penalties.
- Any deliberate effort to disconnect from the internet or leave the game before it has been concluded will result in a 5-0 forfeit (or the final score upon disconnecting, whichever is greater) and automatic dismissal from the tournament. Entry into future tournaments may be denied.
 - If you disconnect accidentally inform your opponent and the administrator by emailing youth@goli.org.uk immediately or it will be deemed as deliberate.
- Purposeful or frequent pausing of the game may result in a 5-0 forfeit and automatic dismissal from the tournament.

- Games must be played within the allocated time frame for each round.
 - Failure to do so will result in both players being eliminated.

Result Recording

- Upon completion of their game, winning players should take a photo of the result screen for proof
- Winning players should then complete the “results” form available at www.goli.org.uk/fifa
- Players are then advised to remove their opponent from their friends list unless they know them personally.
- These steps should be repeated for each round.

Live Streaming and Recording

- If you have agreed to Live Stream your game, this should be done using either Twitch or Mixer.
- The link should then be forwarded to the administrator at youth@goli.org.uk
- The link will then subsequently be shared on GOLI Social Media Pages for followers to watch and enjoy.
- Players should save a highlight of any goals they score which they feel worthy of entry to the “Goal of the Round” competition.
 - GOTR Winners will then be entered in to the “Goal of the Tournament” competition.
- These recordings should then be emailed to youth@goli.org.uk, along with:
 - Your name
 - Your team
 - Your Online ID / Gamertag
 - Your opponent’s Online ID / Gamertag
 - Round number

Reporting

Should you have any issues regarding a players conduct or suspect any breach of the rules, email youth@goli.org.uk with a brief description of the issue, including any evidence (video clip, sound recordings, pictures, etc.), you will then be contacted either for further details or with a determination.
